## Dear Master Gardener Candidate:

The Northwest Regional Horticulture Office of the LSU AgCenter is pleased that you are interested in the Louisiana Master Gardener Program. There are a limited number of spaces available. Class members are chosen in December. If you do not enter the upcoming class, you will need to submit a new application indicating interest in attending the following class.

Classes are scheduled for 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., one day per week for 10 weeks. We take a 30 minute lunch break, pot-luck style meals are provided by the class and volunteers. Classes are scheduled to be held on consecutive Thursday's beginning in January. The first class will be held on January 26<sup>th</sup>. We ask all participants to be on time as class will start sharply at 9:00 a.m.

Participants will be expected to complete 40 volunteer hours. This time can be done, answering homeowner's gardening questions on the telephone, developing and maintaining Extension demonstration gardens, and doing occasional short demonstrations. Training volunteers is the primary Extension objective for this educational program.

There is a \$175.00 registration fee to cover the cost of the manual & supplementary lab supplies. Payment is not required until you are acceptance into the class. Fees should be paid at the start of the first class.
